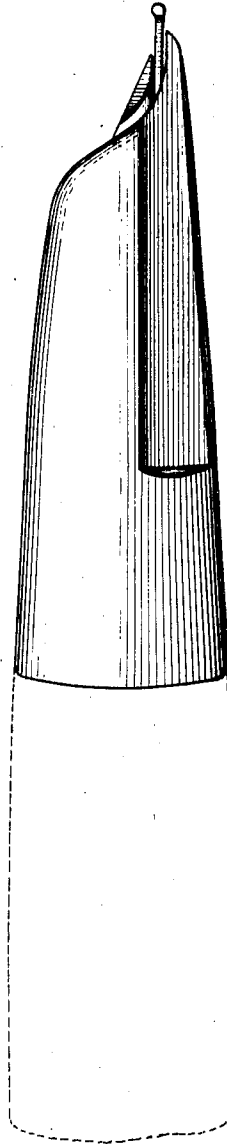

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, George Douglas Cloutier, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a top view of a fountain pen showing

my new design as viewed slightly in perspective from the rearward end of the article; and

Fig. 2 is a fragmentary side view of the same on a larger scale than Fig. 1.

The essential or characterizing portions of the design are shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
