

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Laszlo Moholy-Nagy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, county of Cook, State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawings:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view of the same. The characteristic features of my design reside

in the configuration and appearance of the writing end of the fountain pen.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
