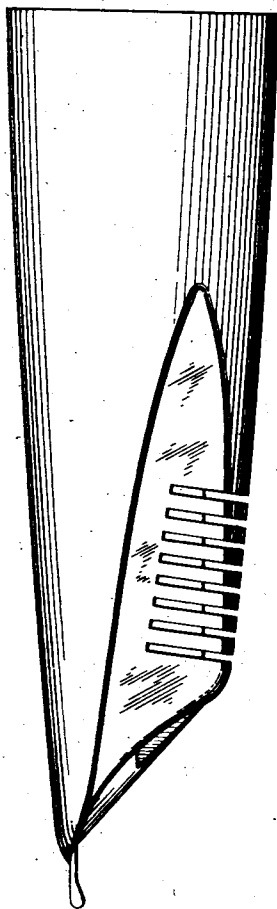

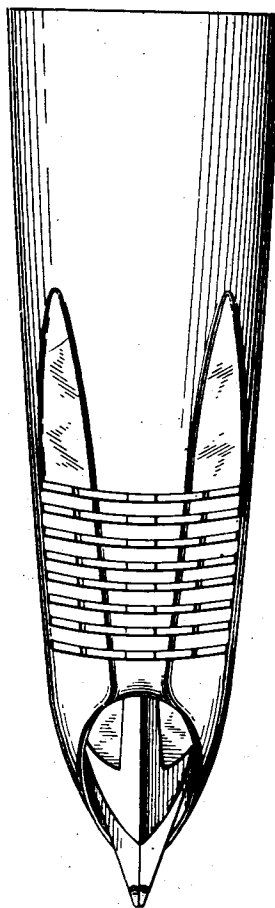
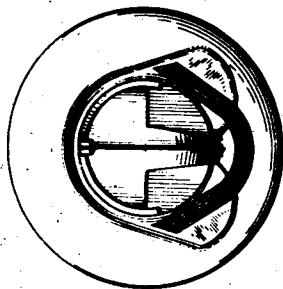

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Juels, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Nib Section for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.
