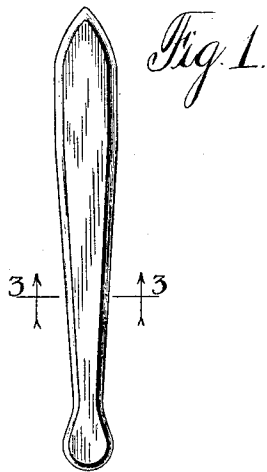

DESIGN FOR A CLIP FOR WRITING INSTRUMENTS

Application filed May 16, 1931. Serial No. 39,873. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM R. CUTHBERT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clip for Writing Instruments, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a clip for writing instruments embodying my new design having a substantially flat front

face with bevelled edges therearound, one end thereof being tapered of curvilinear outline and the other end being ball-shaped;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Figure 1; and

Fig. 3 is a sectional view taken on the line 3—3 of Figure 1.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a clip for writing instruments, substantially as shown and described.
