

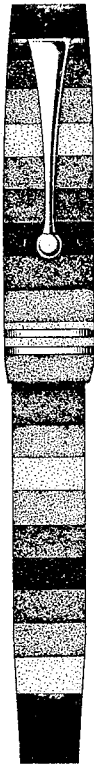

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed March 2, 1931. Serial No. 38,889. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RUSSELL C. PARKER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Janesville, county of Rock, State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

As shown, the design is of a definite character and comprises a plurality of circumferentially disposed color bands arranged in definite groups with the bands comprising the groups of substantially the same color but of varying color intensities.

Thus, as shown, the lowermost group comprises a very light band with the succeeding bands, constituting said group, being of progressively increasing color intensity; the next group, as shown, comprises a light band with superimposed bands of varying darker color.

The figure is a plan view of a fountain pen, showing my new design.

I claim:
