To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Craig R. Sheaffer, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a front elevational view of a fountain pen or similar article showing my new de-

sign, the surface embellishment consisting of longitudinally extending wavy striations of a light lustrous color in a body of darker color, the body dimming the luster of the striations over portions thereof to effect a varying color intensity over the whole.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article substantially as shown and described.
