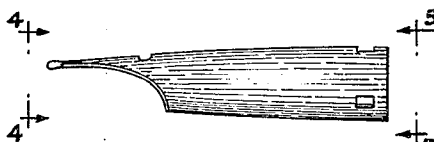

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken between the views of FIGS. 1 and 2 of a fountain pen nib illustrating my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the nib of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the nib of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 3 looking in the direction indicated by the arrows; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 3 looking in the direction indicated by the arrows.
