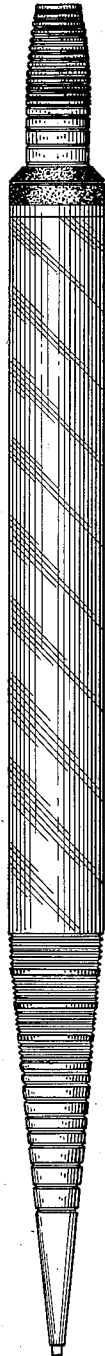

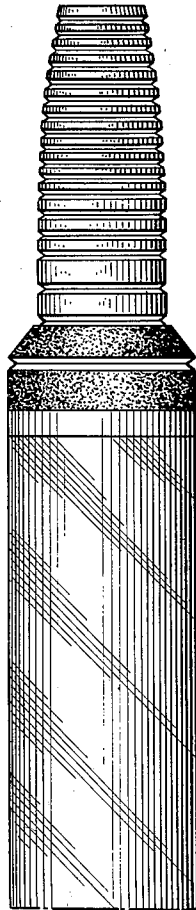

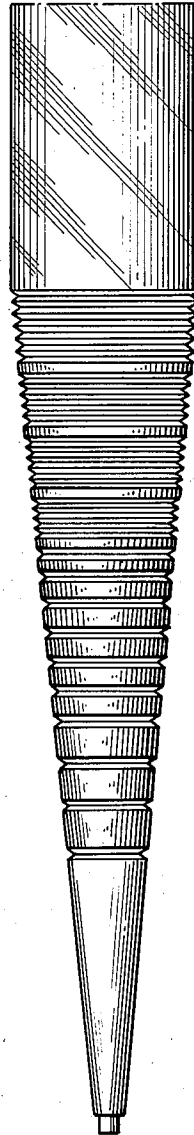

## DESIGN FOR A PENCIL

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Robert J. Lynn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pencils, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a pencil showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is an enlarged elevational view of the upper end portion thereof; and

Fig. 3 is an enlarged elevational view of the lower end portion thereof.
