

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Englewood, in the county of Bergen and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain

pen embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a rear exploded view embodying my design and showing the transparent fountain pen feed member in perspective, contrasting with the color of the barrel member and the cap member;

Fig. 3 is a front elevational view of the foun-

tain pen;

Fig. 4 is a top view of the fountain pen; and tain pen; and

Fig. 5 is a bottom plan view of the fountain

pen.

The design consists of the specific ensemble shown in the drawing and contains as essential features the particular contour set forth in combination with the translucent cap and barrel end members, the latter contrasting in color with the color of the barrel and cap members, both of said members being of the same color, the feed of said fountain pen being transparent and colored differently from the ruby-colored end members.
