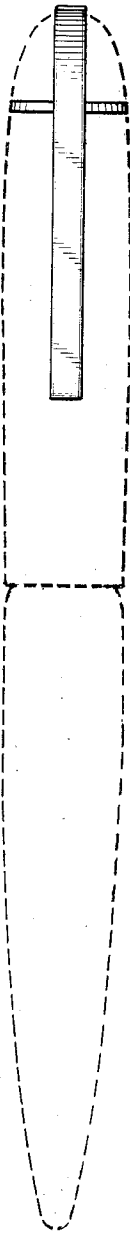

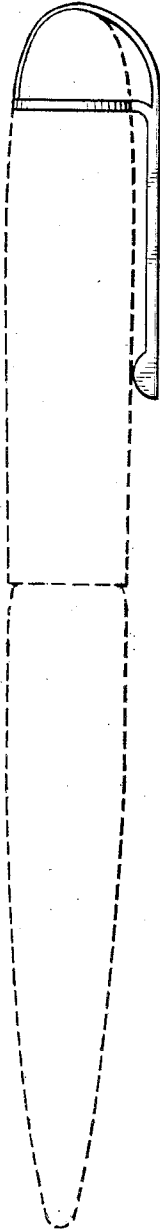
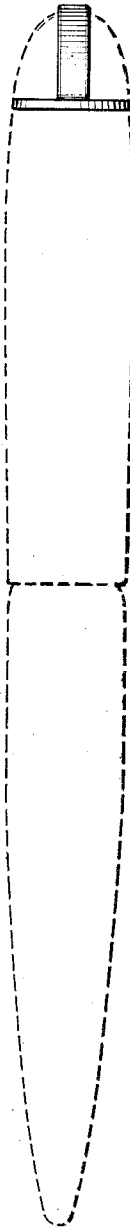

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henry Dreyfuss, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification; reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side view of a fountain pen or similar article embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is another side view of same at approximately 90 degrees from Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a side view of same at approximately 180 degrees from Fig. 1.

The essential features of my design reside in the clip portion shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
