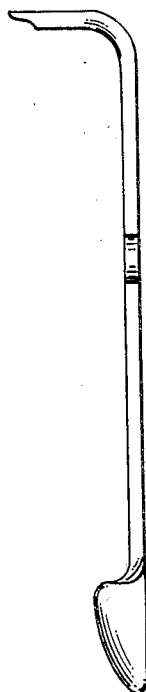
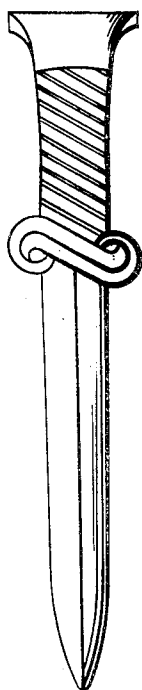

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN AND PENCIL CLIP

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Paul M. Ressinger, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, county of Cook, State of Illinois, and Ivan D. Tefft, a citizen of the United States, residing at Janesville, county of Rock, State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen and Pencil Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein—

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen and pencil clip; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same, showing our new design, the figures being on a greatly enlarged scale.
