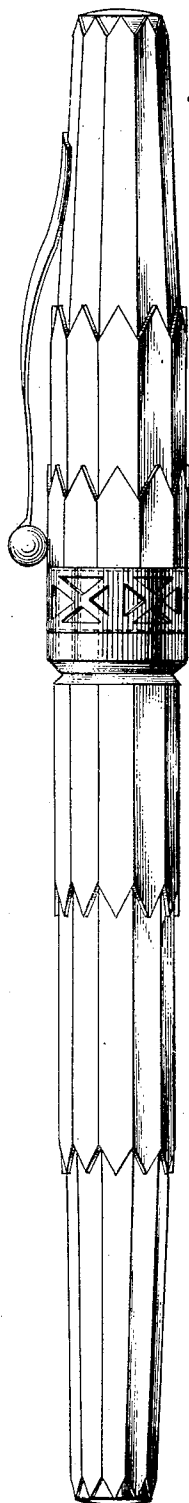

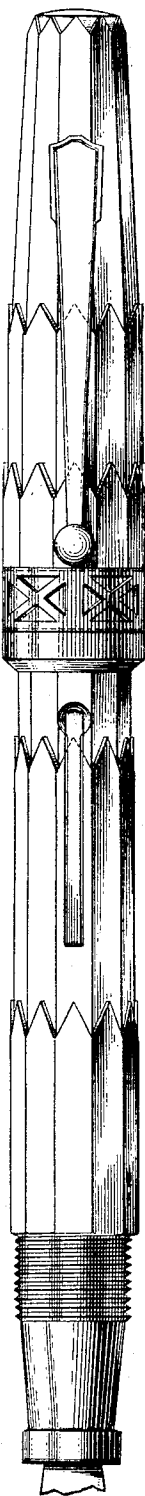

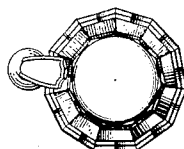

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed May 6, 1932. Serial No. 43,736. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID KAHN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design with a cap applied to the pen end;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view showing the cap removed from the pen end and applied to the barrel end, the pen point being broken away by the necessity of disclosure;

Fig. 3 is a top view of the fountain pen.
