DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

citizen of the United States, residing at Janesville, in the county of Rock and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is an elevation of a pen in one

circumferential position; and

Figure 2 is a similar view of the pen in an

adjacent circumferential position.

The figures of the fountain pen shown on the drawing comprise a series of laminations

of relatively dark and lighter colors super-Be it known that I, Russell C. Parker, a imposed upon each other with either the light or dark color laminations being of pyroxylin which is impregnated with essence of pearl, or a like material, and being of varying color intensity circumferentially of the pen whereby the lighter and darker portions of said lighter color laminations create vertical portions similar to stripes, which are of different shades when viewed at different portions of the pen.

The ornamental design for a fountain pen substantially as shown and described.
