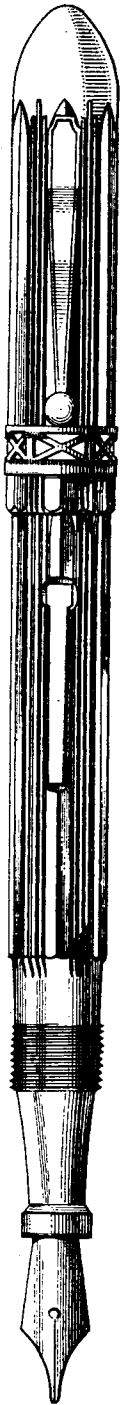

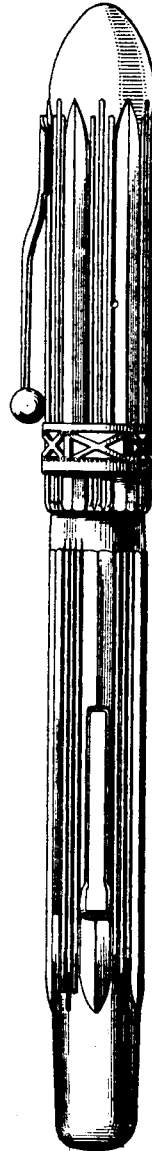

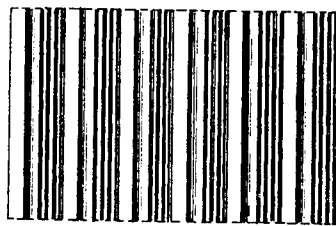
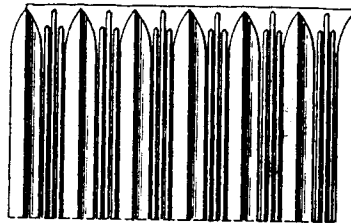

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed September 7, 1932. Serial No. 44,765. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID KAHN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design, the cap being removed from the pen end and applied to the barrel end;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the fountain pen with the cap applied to the pen end;

Fig. 3 is a top end view of the fountain pen;

Fig. 4 is a developed plan showing a portion of the cap ornamentation; and

Fig. 5 is a developed plan showing a portion of the ornamentation of the barrel.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen substantially as shown.
