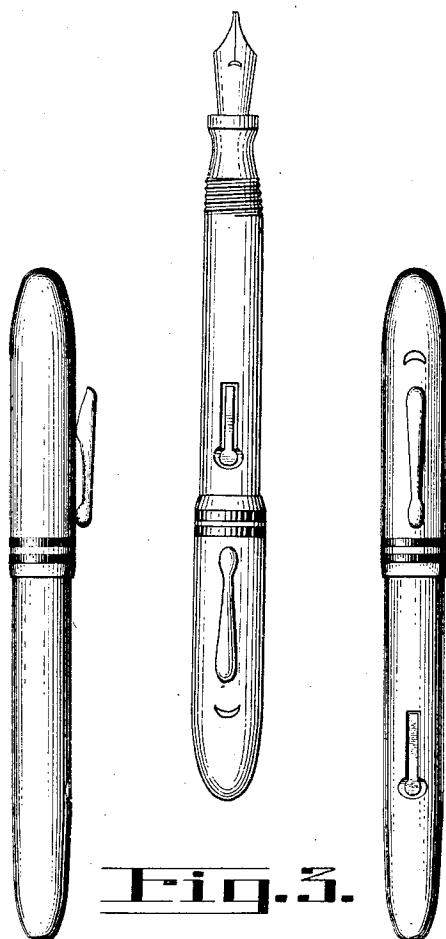

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Application filed September 15, 1930. Serial No. 36,969. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANDREAS BIENENSTEIN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a fountain pen constructed in accordance with my new design;

Figure 2 is a similar view viewed at right angles to Figure 1; and

Fig. 3 is an elevational view of the foun-

tain pen showing the cap removed from the pen end and applied to the other end.

The essential features of my new design are the general outline and shape of the pen; the ornamental surface decorations consisting of spaced encircling bands adjacent the open end of the cap and the crescent adjacent the closed end of the cap; the particular shape of the clip carried by the cap; and the particular shape of the filling lever; all in combination.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen substantially as shown and described.
