

## DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur Winter, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Weehawken, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented the new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which-

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen in a closed position showing my new

design.

Fig. 2 is a view of the cap and pen barrel shown separately.

The essential feature of my design resides in a fountain pen cap which covers a major part of the fountain pen barrel when the fountain pen is in closed position.
