



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Gabriel Larsen, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Ink Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a vertical view of an ink bottle in one position;

Fig. 2 is a view similar to Fig. 1, but showing the bottle partly turned around a vertical axis from the position shown in Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is a top plan view of the bottle.
