

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Theodore J. Piazzoli, a citizen of the United States, residing in Connellsville, county of Fayette, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a bottle illustrating my new design.

In the drawing is shown the bottle as seen from one direction. The bottle is generally symmetrical, however, about two vertical planes intersecting each other at right angles at the center of the bottle neck so that, if the bottle were turned around a vertical axis of 180°, it would have the same appearance as shown in the figure. In other words, the large side appearing in the figure has another substantially identical side directly opposite it, and the same is true of all the other sides appearing in the figure.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a bottle or similar article, substantially as shown, and described.
