





## FOUNTAIN PEN OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Warren Green and Peter Schladermundt, both citizens of the United States, residing in Noroton Heights, county of Fairfield, and State of Connecticut, and Bronxville, county of Westchester, and State of New York, respectively, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front view of a fountain pen with a cap assembled thereon, shown our design;

Fig. 2 is a side view of the pen with the cap assembled thereon;

Fig. 3 is a front view of the pen without the cap; and

Fig. 4 is a top view looking down on the cap of the complete assembly.

The essential features of our design for a fountain pen reside in the parts shown in full lines, the fountain pen being characterized by the short cap with circumferential lines at the top; the clip extending below the cap and touching the barrel of the fountain pen; and the short stubby nose effect of the pen when seen particularly in Fig. 3.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or the like, substantially as shown and described.
