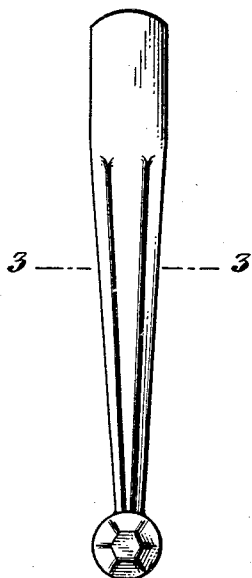

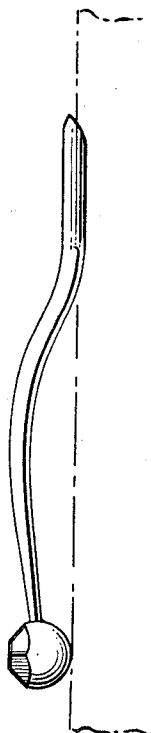
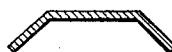

DESIGN FOR A PEN AND PENCIL CLIP

Application filed December 17, 1929. Serial No. 33,821. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HARRY ESTEROW, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pen and Pencil Clips, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof, in which—

Figure 1 is front elevation of a pen and pencil clip, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the same, and

Figure 3 is a sectional view on the line 3—3 of Figure 1.
