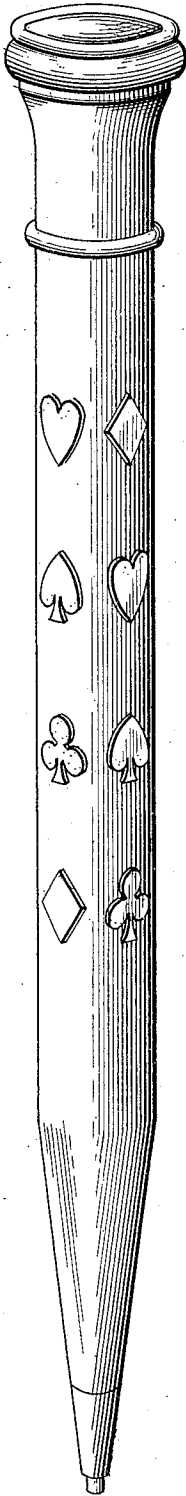

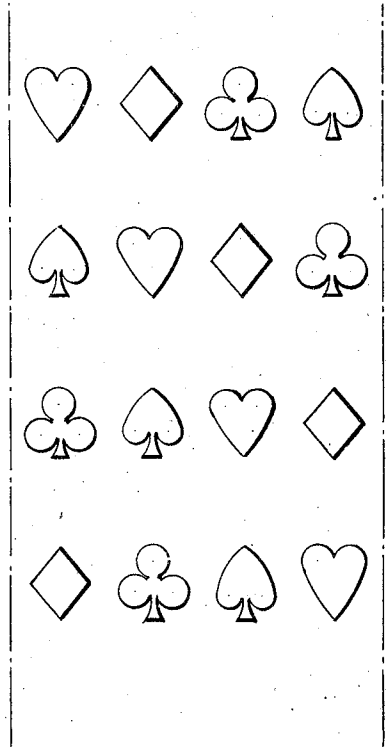

## DESIGN FOR A PEN OR PENCIL CASE.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN C. WAHL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, and whose post-office address is 1800 Roscoe street, Chicago, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pen and Pencil Cases, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Referring to the figures:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of the

well-known Eversharp pencil ornamented with my new design on the circumference of the pencil case, and

Fig. 2 is a view of my new design, developed on a plane.

The particular figures upon the pencil are set forth prominently by engine turning the barrel about the figures and leaving the figures smooth.

I claim:
