DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

John Hill, Hillside, N. J., assignor to Celluloid Corporation, a corporation of New Jersey

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John Hill, a subject of the King of England, residing at Hillside, county of Union, State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pens, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing:

The figure is a plan view of a fountain pen showing my new design.

The ornamentation of the fountain pen shown on the drawing comprises slanting and substantially parallel strata of contrasting color effects, the ends of which meet or approach similar strata slanting in opposite direction.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
